

WARRANTY FOR AXIOM CLOUDS IN A KIT



Armstrong World Industries Ltd, Armstrong House, 38 Market Square, Uxbridge, Middlesex UB8 1NG (“Armstrong”) guarantees that **Axiom Canopy** “in a kit system” (defined as Axiom perimeter trim systems (delivered in a kit form) and a selected range of Armstrong ceiling tiles (excluding Madera wood tiles) which are designed to create full panel installations for “ceiling clouds” when installed together) is warranted to be free from defects in materials and factory workmanship for a period of **10 years** from the date of installation subject to the conditions set forth below.

- A The material must be installed in accordance with all applicable Armstrong specifications in effect at the time of installation.
- B Installation must not be carried out in areas with humidity in excess of 95%, chemical fumes, freezing temperature, and/or vibration. Following installation, these environmental conditions must be maintained.
- C The ceiling panels must not bear the weight of any unauthorised loads.
- D Prior to installation, the material must be stored in a dry and clean area that is enclosed and protected from the elements, (i.e. rain, snow or other causes of excessive moisture) and stabilised in the area for not less than 24 hours prior to installation.
- E The Axiom Canopy cable hanging system must not be attached to or hung from any commercial ceiling suspension system.
- F The Axiom Canopy perimeter trim system is only installed with ceiling panels from the specified Armstrong ceiling products shown in the Axiom Canopy brochure.

- G The Axiom canopy hanging system must not be used to support any other object or material other than as provided in the specifications.
- H The Axiom Canopy must not be installed with other than manufacturer-provided hardware.
- I The Axiom canopy must not be cut, drilled, or altered in any way, including field painting.

Prima and 95 RH products are not designed to be installed in standing water environments such as indoor pools and outdoor applications.

Should the material show defects inc. sag Armstrong must be advised in writing within thirty (30) days after such defect was first observed. Where Armstrong confirms such failure, Armstrong will at its expense, deliver **to the site** new material of the same type and grade in an amount equal to that which has sagged.

If replacement material is unavailable, alternative product selected by Armstrong will be supplied.

The delivery of such material shall constitute the total liability of Armstrong in respect of the defective material. Armstrong so far as the applicable law permits shall not be responsible for any installation or replacement costs or for incidental or consequential damages of any nature whatsoever and all other warranties or guarantees expressed or implied including any provision that the material is merchantable or fit for a particular purpose are hereby excluded.
